Other material may include research and compiled records about area veterans, as well as programs and ephemera from commemorative events and anniversaries.

ARRANGEMENT: The bulk of the collection, Series I: Veterans, has original materials concerning veterans and is organized alphabetically by the last name of the veteran. Series II: Veterans History includes research about veterans in the Winchester-Frederick County area, and Series III: Commemorative Events includes programs and other ephemera from memorials and anniversaries.

IMMEDIATE SOURCE OF ACQUISITION: Material in this collection is derived from a variety of sources, including donation, research by Archives staff and volunteers, and oral history interview projects.
