SCOPE AND CONTENT: The Wilmer Kerns Collection contains genealogical research about families living in the Winchester-Frederick and Hampshire County area in the eighteenth and nineteenth centuries, including photocopies of his articles from the *West Virginia Advocate* (1983-1992). Folders may include correspondence concerning family history research, family group sheets and other genealogical documents, copies of records and other supporting documents, articles, newspaper articles, original papers, and photographs. Wilmer Kerns is the compiler of the research unless otherwise noted.

There are also copies of several Frederick County Road petitions, a record book for Nelson's Chapel, and documents concerning the Grove families, John Parish, John Wolford, Doctors McGuire (both father and son), and the account book of Aaron Kerns.

BIOGRAPHICAL/HISTORICAL: Dr. Kerns is a genealogist and historian of the Lower Shenandoah Valley, and the author of several books concerning Fredrick County, VA and Hampshire County, WV.

Nelson's Chapel, also known as the Railroad Union Sabbath School, was a United Brethren in Christ Church that was located near Cross Junction. The record book included in the collection is the only record of the church's existence. This collection also contains a list of charter members of the church, a brief history by Wilmer L. Kerns, a list of members from when the chapel was reorganized in 1908, and a list of members in 1918.

ARRANGEMENT: Folders in boxes 1 to 28 are organized alphabetically by last name. Folders may include subfolders. Box 29 contains local history including articles written by Dr. Kerns concerning historic places.

RELATED MATERIAL: Wilmer Kerns was a veteran of the Korean War. His memoirs can be found in the Korean War Collection, 1447 WFCBS.
