BIOGRAPHICAL/HISTORICAL: Alpha Phi Omega is a collegiate fraternity that was founded at Lafayette College in 1925. It grew to become both a national and international organization. From 1929 to 1931, the national headquarters was in Winchester, Virginia. *Torch and Trefoil* is the official publication of the organization. This collection has two volumes, both from 1950.
