SCOPE AND CONTENT: Miscellaneous Manuscript Files (MMF) are small collections typically containing only a folder or two of materials. This folder contains a pardon issued by the John Letcher, Governor of Virginia, to Ellen Afto, a Frederick County woman.

BIOGRAPHICAL/HISTORICAL: The pardon shows that Ellen Afto had been condemned by the Circuit Court of Frederick County to be sold into absolute slavery as punishment. John Letcher, Governor of Virginia from 1860 to 1864, issued her a pardon. The circumstances of the punishment are unknown.
