BIOGRAPHICAL/HISTORICAL: The book contains numerous customer accounts listing payments mostly for dry goods and whiskey. It also contains the signatures (or marks) of fourteen men subscribing to an "Oath of Allegiance and Fealty to the States as directed by Law" in 1782.
