SCOPE AND CONTENT: Miscellaneous Manuscript Files (MMF) are small collections typically containing only a folder or two of materials. This folder contains both original and photocopied documents from the Dunbar Female Institute, also known as the Dunbar Seminary, of Winchester, VA.

BIOGRAPHICAL/HISTORICAL: The Dunbar Female Institute was founded in 1858 in Winchester, Virginia. The school appears to have operated at Fort Loudoun during the Civil War and the principal was Rev. James B. Avirett. It closed in 1872.

IMMEDIATE SOURCE OF ACQUISITION: Acquired as gifts from several donors.
