SCOPE AND CONTENT: The Sherry Brumback Jenkins Collection contains a variety of materials documenting the Brumback family of Frederick County, Virginia, and allied families. The Collection includes a ledger for the medical practice of Dr. Isaac Milton Longacre Brumback, and an account book of H. M. Brumback, materials concerning Round Hill Community Center, yearbooks for Middletown High School, correspondence, legal documents, and photographs. Members of the Griffith, Long, Snapp, Hamar, and Hollar families are also represented in this collection.

BIOGRAPHICAL/HISTORICAL: Isaac Milton Brumback (1846-1926) was the son of Joseph Brumback (1810-1874) and Cristina Huffman (1816-1912), both of Page County, Virginia. The couple moved to Frederick County and settled on a farm on Cedar Creek Grade, Fawcett Gap, near Opequon. Isaac married Euphrasia Ellenor Funkhouser in 1874 and they had ten children. His son, Harman Milton Brumback (1885-1980), continued to farm in Frederick County.
