**SCOPE AND CONTENT**: This collection contains the personal papers of members of the Tidball family and William Alexander, including accounts, correspondence, and legal preparation. In addition, due to the occupations of both Thomas A. Tidball and William Alexander, there are court/legal records of Winchester/Frederick County residents.

**BIOGRAPHICAL/HISTORICAL**: The patriarch of the Tidball family in Winchester was Joseph Tidball. He was born in 1751 in Chester, PA, and he married Jane Allen Scott. They had a number of children including Thomas Allen Tidball and Alexander Scott Tidball. Joseph Tidball died in Frederick County in 1805.

Thomas Allen Tidball was born in 1786 in Pennsylvania. He married Susan Watkins Hill on November 18, 1813 in Philadelphia, PA. They had three children reach adulthood: Joseph Tidball (1816-1861), Alexander Scott Tidball (1819-1884), Elizabeth Morton Hill Tidball (Thurston) (1825-1904). Thomas was the third Clerk of Frederick County, serving from 1824 until his death in 1856. He is credited with building the Old Town Spring house in 1820. He died on April 6, 1856 in Winchester, VA.

Alexander Scott Tidball was born on January 19, 1796 in Philadelphia, PA. He married Millicent S. McGuire on December 19, 1822 in Winchester VA. They had 11 children including, Edward McGuire Tidball (1823-1877), Thomas Allen Tidball (1825-1852), Alfred Powell Tidball (1827-1857), Elizabeth Holmes Tidball (1829-1840), Jane Scott Tidball (1832-1913), Rebecca J. Tidball (1833-1895), Frances Tidball (1835-1937), Mary M. Tidball (1838-1864), Elizabeth H. Tidball (1840-1923), Susan A. Tidball (1842-1865), Lucy P. Tidball (1844-1864). Alexander Scott bought the Daniel Morgan house in 1824 and sold it in 1842. He died on January 3, 1848 and is buried in Winchester, VA.

William R. Alexander was born in Clarke County in 1849. He married Annie R. Willis. William went to law school at UVA and moved to Winchester in 1875. Shortly thereafter, he was elected the Commonwealth Attorney for the city, a position he held for 4 terms. He tried unsuccessfully to obtain the Democratic party's

nomination as candidate for Congress from 7<sup>th</sup> congressional district. In 1890 he was elected mayor of Winchester. While campaigning for the Democratic party's nomination for attorney general of Virginia in 1897, he became sick with tuberculosis. He was sent to Florida to recuperate, but it didn't work. He died at his home *Hawthorne* on December 23, 1898. In his *Winchester Times* obit, it says he "lacked political judgement, combined with an indisposition to take the advice of his friends" that prevented him from being more successful in politics.

Hawthorne is one of the oldest homes in town and is connected to both the Tidball family and William Alexander. Joseph Tidball is said to have built Fair Mont, a home off present-day Fairmont Ave (311 Fairmont). Less than a decade after building his home, it is said that he exchanged homes with Alfred Powell for Hawthorne, a home Powell recently completed building off Amherst Street (610 Amherst). Hawthorne was first built by James Wood, Jr (governor of VA from 1796-1799). From 1803-1811, Lawrence Washington (son of George Washington's brother Samuel) lived there with his wife Mary Dorcas Wood (granddaughter of James Wood). Then Alfred Powell took over the property and built the present version of the home. After that, it was sold to the Tidball family. Thomas A. Tidball's (son of Joseph Tidball) executors sold Hawthorne to the McDonald family in 1856. Mrs. McDonald struggled during the Civil War to keep the home and her children safe. She was forced to flee when the battlefield surrounded her home in 1863. After the Civil War, now a widow, Mrs. McDonald sold the house. William Alexander would purchase Hawthorne in the later part of the 1800s.

**IMMEDIATE SOURCE OF ACQUISITION**: Received from the collections of the Winchester-Frederick County Historical Society. The original donor of the collection is unknown; however, given the connections with *Hawthorne*, it is possible that the papers were found at the house and deposited by the then owners.
