**BIOGRAPHICAL/HISTORICAL**: The Winchester Classical School was an all-male school intended to be a preparatory for the University of Virginia. The circular indicates that the curriculum emphasized surveying and civil and topographical engineering. The principal is listed as A. M. (Archibald Magill) Smith (1835-1918), who later founded the Shenandoah Valley Academy in Winchester, Virginia in 1867.
