SCOPE AND CONTENT: The Winchester City Government Records contains documents/records concerning operations and activities undertaken by city of Winchester, Virginia. This includes city codes and records for various departments including fire, finance, personnel, planning and zoning, police, public utilities, and public works. The collection also includes maps of the city, and tax and local books for the years 1870-1910. Most of the information is dated during the 1900s. The City of Winchester personnel office is the official repository for city council minutes.

BIOGRAPHICAL/HISTORICAL: Colonel James Wood founded Winchester in 1744 as the first British settlement west of the Blue Ridge Mountains on land granted by Thomas, Lord Fairfax. In 1754, the Virginia State Assembly gave the Town of Winchester its charter, giving it jurisdiction over its government. Then in 1874 the Town of Winchester became the City of Winchester, independent of Frederick County, though the city remains the county seat.
