SCOPE AND CONTENT: Miscellaneous Manuscript Files (MMF) are small collections typically containing only a folder or two of materials. This folder contains a stock certificate in Winchester and Berry's Ferry Turnpike Company.

BIOGRAPHICAL/HISTORICAL: Berry's Ferry across the Potomac River and into Maryland was established in the late 18th Century. In 1812, the Virginia General Assembly approved the incorporation of turnpike companies partially subsidized by local private funding and state taxes. Out of this, the Winchester and Berry's Ferry Turnpike was established (present-day Route 50 east of Winchester).
