**SCOPE AND CONTENT**: Miscellaneous Manuscript Files (MMF) are small collections typically containing only a folder or two of materials. This folder contains a notebook used to record the constitution, member names and minutes of the Yeakley School Debating Society. It documents topics that were debated which include the mental capacities of women versus men, slavery and capital punishment.

**BIOGRAPHICAL/HISTORICAL**: The Yeakley School was one of the first sixteen public schools constructed (as opposed to existing private schools converted to public use) in Frederick County following an act of the General Assembly of 1869-1870 for the establishment of public schools in Virginia. It was part of the Gainesboro District and was constructed in 1878 on land conveyed by Henry Glaize and James Yeakley and his wife. It was located about six miles northwest of Winchester on a road leading from North Frederick Grade to Indian Hollow.
