- **Joint Archives**: R. Bacon reported on several upcoming programs during the months of October and November.
- **6. Director's Report:** *Presented by A. White, Deputy Director*
 - The Library enjoyed and incredible month of community engagement and support through its programming and promotional efforts.
 - In support of the Campaign for Grade Level Reading an Early Childhood Educator's class will be revamped and restarted with Dr. Christen Johnson, EdD from Laurel Ridge.

- The Library is working with The Library Corporation (TLC) to move to a new version of the cataloging system.
- It appears the budget for The Institute of Museum and Library Services (IMLS) will be significantly restored by the Federal Government.
- Likewise, the Library of Virginia has received complete federal funding for the remainder of its current fiscal year.
- After meeting with the E-rate team, the Library is looking to be able to upgrade network speeds as well as the possibility of some newer equipment.
- As the use of AI is increasingly being used in libraries, a presentation on the topic will be part of this year's Staff Development Day.
- Almost all HRLS use statistics are trending upward as shown in the chart prepared by A. White.

7. Frederick County and City of Winchester Board Liaisons:

Frederick County Supervisor John Jewell reported on the changes taking place within the Board of Supervisors and their procedures.
